

HOME CLUB DIRECTORS TRAINING CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT JUNE – AUGUST

- 4 Online lessons and 2 f2f practical session each lesson is approximately 3 hours in length
- followed by an Online revision session and a wrap-up online quiz session.
- 8 sessions in total
- This course is designed to support clubs by training (and encouraging) candidates in basic directing skills and very importantly to develop confidence to **direct sessions** at their home club.
- Note: This course is not meant in anyway to substitute for, the present accreditation regime; rather it will provide a stepping stone towards undertaking full accreditation for those who are interested.

The Online Sessions are open to all throughout NZ using the Zoom Platform These sessions will also "introduce "existing available resources encouraging candidates to use these resources as required

The Practical Sessions are presently only arranged for the Wellington Region, but other Regional committees and /or individual clubs should be able to organize some or all of these practical sessions at various clubs in their regions.

The practical sessions will put into practice the "theory from the online course. All content for these practical sessions will be supplied : easy to use presentation material, answers and a "marking "sheet to record candidates performance.

The help of the Regional Committees / Individual clubs is necessary for this program to work effectively in their region .

A special online session will be run to " train" others to run these practical sessions. Regional Committees and individual clubs can set their own dates/times for these practical sessions.

Certificate of Achievement

The accumulative marks obtained by regular and active participation, practical training assessment, and the online quiz, will be used to determine the awarding of a Certificate of Achievement. A pass mark will be 50%, an A grade pass will be 65% and a pass with distinction above 80%
